Acts 17:30-34

³⁰ Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should repent,

³¹ because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead.” ³² Now when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some began to sneer, but others said, “We shall hear you again concerning this.”

³³ So Paul went out of their midst. ³⁴ But some men joined him and believed, among whom also were Dionysius the Areopagite and a woman named Damaris and others with them.

1. God has set a judgement day for the world.

Because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead.” Acts 7:31

2. God will judge the world through the Lord Jesus Christ.

3. Jesus Christ is the judge of the living and the dead.

4. Jesus Christ will bring judgement on those who reject the gospel.

⁷ and to give relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, ⁸ dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. ⁹ These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power. 2 Thess. 1:7-9
