Exodus 20:1-3, 35:27-28

Then God spoke all these words, saying,
² “I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. ³ “You shall have no other gods before Me.”

²⁷The rulers brought the onyx stones and the stones for setting for the ephod and for the breastpiece; ²⁸ and the spice and the oil for the light and for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense.

Focal Truth:

God's first word – You shall have
God as your God.

1. There is only one eternal true God.

Then God spoke all these words, saying...

Ex. 20:1

2. There is only one true God who can save us from sin and death.

“I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.” Ex. 20:2

3. You must have the true God only for your God.

“You shall have no other gods before Me.”

Ex. 20:3

God is our God when we:

- Choose Him – Deut. 26:17
- Fear Him – Pr. 1:7
- Trust Him – Jer. 17:7
- Love Him – Matt. 22:37
- Obey Him – Deut. 6:6

4. You must have no false gods in the place of the true God.

“You shall have no other gods before Me.”

Ex. 20:3

Ways of putting false gods in the place of God:

- When we trust anything more than God
- When we love anything more than God

Daily Use:

- Do you believe that there is a God?
- Have you sinned by trusting in false gods?
- You must repent of your sin of rejecting God for false gods.
