

## Jacob's Family Secrets

Genesis 34:30 & 47:9

<sup>30</sup> Then Jacob said to Simeon and Levi, "You have brought trouble on me by making me odious among the inhabitants of the land, among the Canaanites and the Perizzites; and my men being few in number, they will gather together against me and attack me and I will be destroyed, I and my household."

<sup>9</sup> So Jacob said to Pharaoh, "The years of my sojourning are one hundred and thirty; few and unpleasant have been the years of my life, nor have they attained the years that my fathers lived during the days of their sojourning."

## Focal Truth:

Jacob trusted God yet was deeply grieved by the sins of his children.

## Observations:

- 1. Jacob by faith experienced God's promised blessings. Gen. 28:15
- 2. Jacob by faith experienced personal loss even with God's blessing. Gen. 35:19
- 3. Jacob by faith lived in grief because of the painful and sinful acts of his children. Gen.34:2

## Things to Remember and Do:

- 1. Every child is a sinner who must be saved by the grace of God.
- 2. God gives endurance to parents in their grief over their children. Heb. 10:36
- 3. Trust God when your children live in sin!
- 4. Wait on God to do His work in their life!
- 5. Godly parents let your light shine so that your children will see your good works and glorify God!
