Focal Truth: Our primary ministry is to proclaim the gospel because only in proclaiming the gospel is the glory of God revealed to those blind and lost in sin.

 4. The Gospel Reveals the Glory of God in the Face of
Jesus Christ. (v.6)
 5. The Gospel Compels Us to not Lose Heart. (v.1)
