Luke 20:17-18

But Jesus looked at them and said, “What then is this that is written:

‘THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED,
THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER stone’?

Everyone who falls on that stone will be broken to pieces; but on whomever it falls, it will scatter him like dust.”

Focal Truth:

Jesus Christ rejected in unbelief has become the foundation of the church.

Observations:

1. Jesus Christ was rejected in unbelief by the Jewish religious leaders. – Luke 19:47
2. Jesus Christ the rejected one is the promised Messiah. – Luke 20:17
3. Jesus Christ the rejected one will judge those who do not believe in Him. – Luke 20:18

Things to Remember and Do:

1. Come to Jesus Christ as the living stone chosen and precious to God. – 1 Pet. 2:4
2. Believers in Christ are being built into a spiritual house of priests to God. – 1 Pet. 2:5
3. Believers in Christ – priests to God offer spiritual sacrifices to God through Jesus Christ. – 1 Pet. 2:5
4. There is no greater value than believing in Jesus Christ. – 1 Pet. 2:7
5. Jesus is the rock of stumbling for those who will not believe in Him. – 1 Pet. 2:8
