Preparation – Luke 19:26

Luke 19:26

²⁶ I tell you that to everyone who has, more shall be given, but from the one who does not have, even what he does have shall be taken away.

Focal Truth:

Believers will be rewarded for doing the business of the Lord.

Observations:

1. Believers must do the Lord's business until He returns. – Luke 19:12-13
2. Believers who do the Lord's business will be rewarded when He returns. – Luke 19:15-26
3. Unbelievers who refuse Christ's Lordship will be judged when He returns. – Luke 19:14,27

Things to Remember and Do:

1. Only one life t'will soon be past, only what's done for Christ will last.
2. Do the Lord's business not your business!
3. Faithfulness in the Lord's business produces more spiritual good on earth and heaven.
4. When the Lord returns – He will judge and destroy those who do not believe in Him.
